Training

Introduction

The reach truck operator course aims to provide novice, semi-skilled or competence assessment of existing operators. There are two levels for this training. The one day course is intended as an assessment of competence for existing reach truck operators who hold valid certification. It is also suitable for operators holding a valid certificate to upgrade to a heavier lifting capacity forklift. The three day course is intended for novice operators with little or no experience.

The course covers both theory and practical and where possible, will relate to the work experience of candidates. It is designed to give a hands-on appreciation and will include practical assessment.

Course Content:

Classroom instruction on

- Legislation
- Operators' safety code
- Forklift truck stability
- Factors causing forward / sideways tipping
- Familiarization of different machines

Practical instruction on

Pre-start and operational checks

Driving and maneuvering

Stacking / de-stacking at low level, eye level and high level

Correct shutdown and parking procedures

Familiarization of different machines, where applicable / possible
